Grey Balance Card

Your Grey Balance Card combines a precision **18% neutral grey target** with an integrated **multi-step grayscale strip** — two tools in one card for accurate exposure, white balance, and tonal verification.



How to use it

THREE STEPS · ~2 MINUTES



01 Set exposure & white balance

- ✓ Set your **exposure** to your desired settings.
- ✓ Place the card where your subject will be, **angled directly toward the camera** to minimize reflections.
- ✓ Set your camera to **manual white balance** and aim at the large 18% grey target area of the card.



02 Capture a reference image

- ✓ Take a **photo of the card** under your current lighting.
- ✓ This reference shot is what you'll use in post to confirm **exposure and white balance**.
- ✓ Return the card to its **protective sleeve** when done.



03 Verify in your editing software

- ✓ Open the reference image in **Lightroom, Capture One**, or your preferred editor.
- ✓ Confirm white balance using the **large grey target**.
- ✓ Use the **multi-step grayscale strip** to set white, grey, and black points — verifying tonal reproduction from highlights to shadows.

! SHORT ON TIME?

Skip in-camera setup. Fix it in post.

If you can't set white balance on set, simply **capture a reference photo of the card under your shooting conditions**. In post, use the 18% grey target and grayscale strip to dial in exposure, white balance, and tonal values — no guessing, no endless slider adjustments.

FIELD WORKFLOW

- 1 Shoot one frame with the card visible in your scene.
- 2 Continue shooting normally under the same light.
- 3 In post, eyedropper the grey target to balance the set.



CARD CARE

Keep your card **reading true**.

Pocket-size at 3.11" x 4.53" (79 x 115 mm). A few simple habits keep your reference surface accurate, shoot after shoot.

- ✓ Always **return the card to its protective sleeve** after use.
- ✗ **Avoid touching the target surfaces** — oils from skin can affect accuracy.
- ✓ Store in a **cool, dry place** away from direct sunlight.

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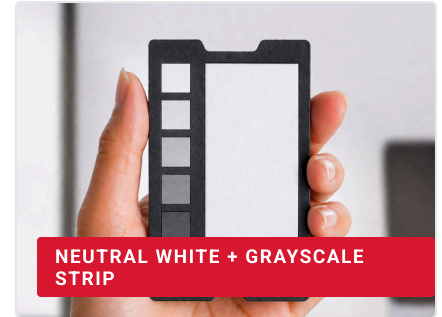

How to use it

- ✓ Set your camera to **manual white balance** and aim at the large white target area of the card.
- ✓ **Tip:** Set your exposure to your desired settings first.



02 Capture a reference image

- ✓ Take a **photo of the card** under your current lighting.
- ✓ This reference shot is what you'll use in post to confirm **white balance and tonal values**.
- ✓ Return the card to its **protective sleeve** when done.



03 Verify in your editing software

- ✓ Open the reference image in **Lightroom, Capture One**, or your preferred editor.
- ✓ Confirm white balance using the **large white target**.
- ✓ Use the **multi-step grayscale strip** to evaluate highlight and shadow detail — checking tonal reproduction before finalizing your edit.

- ✗ **Avoid touching the target surfaces** — oils from skin can affect accuracy.
